All double degree study programmes in cooperation with universities abroad are implemented as full-time study programmes.

All other doctoral study programmes are implemented as full-time study programmes or as a combination of full-time and part-time study.

The standard period of study in DSP is four years. In doctoral study programmes implemented in the Czech language students can receive a scholarship throughout the whole standard period of study in full-time type of study.

All announced doctoral study programme, with the exception of the programme 'Conservation Sciences in Cultural Heritage Preservation', are accredited also to be implemented in the English language.

Study applications on a required form, including the mandatory annexes listed on the website of <u>UCT Prague</u>, and supplemented with an assessment of medical fitness for study in the chosen field of dissertation shall be submitted **by 15 April 2024** at the latest.
